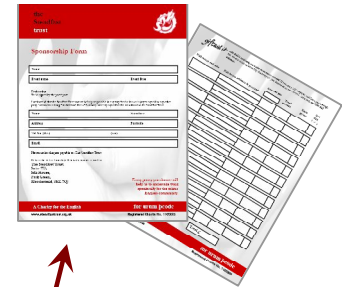


Website Update - Sponsorship Form Available
