### Fundraiser Week

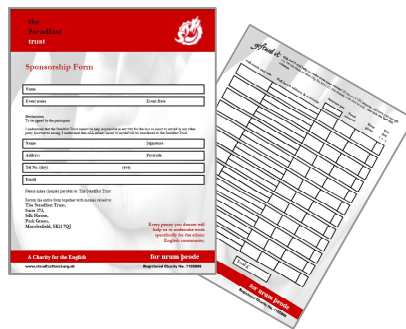
