Folkmoot Social

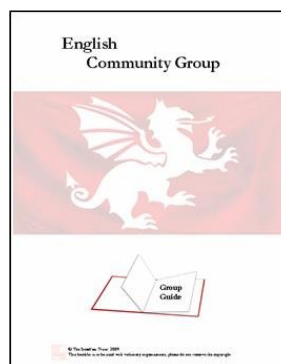
